



TWYFORD COLTS CRICKET CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS

Twyford Colts Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the relevant Lead Coach, Team Manager or Welfare Officer.

As a member of Twyford Colts Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their Lead Coach or Team Manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions. Compulsory items will be communicated at the beginning of every season by the relevant Lead Coach/ Team Manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are expected to behave properly at all times. Poor behaviour not only shows a lack of respect for those in charge but can also be extremely dangerous. Any such behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind, except for medicinal purposes, on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
